



LEFT OVER FOOD POLICY

We often receive requests for left over food to be packaged so it can be taken home. Our policy is that we do not allow food, cooked or uncooked, that has been prepared for functions to be taken home by the client.

By following legal health & safety standards we are not permitted to allow anyone to remove food from the premises. Once food has reached room temperature the chance of spoilage, contamination and potential food poisoning increases dramatically. For us to allow you to take food home, that has not been consumed as its optimal time, exposes you and your family to potential food related illnesses, and to do so would be in breach of our duty of care to you as our valued client.

EXTERNAL CATERING

Under no circumstances do we permit any external catering, including chips, biscuits, dips, nuts & lollies to be brought into the Club. If these items are required they can be provided by our caterers, please see the Functions Co-Ordinator for further information. Celebration cakes are an exception.

PRIVATE FUNCTIONS, MINORS & ALCOHOL

Many people are under the impression that because they are holding a private function that is ok to serve underage guests alcoholic beverages. The Goulburn Soldiers Club is a fully licensed premises and there are stiff penalties for the Club, its staff and you for allowing minors to consume alcohol on the premises. If you or your guests break the law by purchasing alcohol on behalf of a minor you may end up having your membership suspended and the party closed down with no refunds given.

21ST BIRTHDAY PARTIES AND UNDER 18's FUNCTIONS

21st Birthday Parties and under 18's Functions (eg School Functions, Formals & Parties) must have security guards present at the function, please discuss pricing and ratios with the Functions Co-Ordinator.
